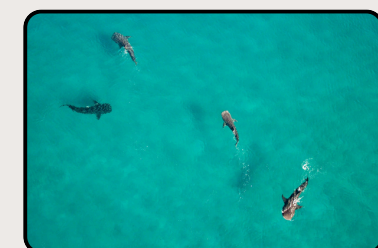

- Mafia Island hosts whale sharks during their migration season from October to March, offering one of the best opportunities in the world to swim with these magnificent creatures in their natural habitat
