- The park features Mount Meru, a dormant volcano and Tanzania's second-highest peak, perfect for stunning treks and views.
- The park is renowned for its diverse range of wildlife, including species you might not find in other Tanzanian parks. Notably, it's one of the few places where you can see the rare and elusive black-and-white colobus monkeys. These monkeys have strikingly beautiful fur and are often seen in the park's forested areas.
- The park's seven alkaline lakes are known for their vibrant colors and attract a variety of bird species, including flamingos.
