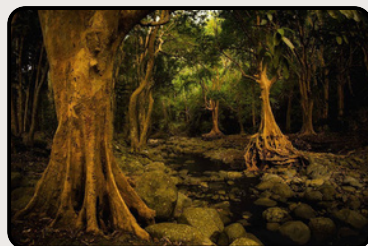

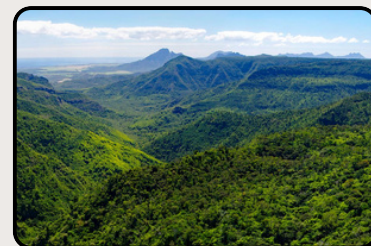

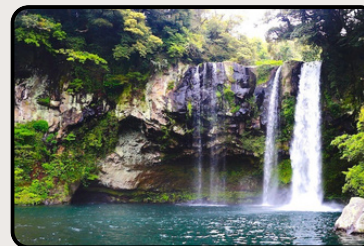

DID YOU KNOW?

- The park protects rare species like the Mauritius kestrel, which was rescued from near extinction.
- The park contains some of the last remaining stretches of Mauritian forest, preserving a unique array of flora and fauna that existed on the island long before human settlement.
- From viewpoints like Alexandra Falls Lookout, visitors can see the dramatic contrast between the lush green forests and the rugged black volcanic rock formations that give the park its name.
