 - Follow designated paths to protect the park's delicate ecosystems and avoid getting lost.
 - Use local guides for hikes and wildlife spotting
 - Maintain a safe distance from animals to avoid disturbing them

- DID YOU KNOW?**
- Udzungwa is home to several endemic primates, including the critically endangered Sanje mangabey and the Udzungwa red colobus, which are found only in this region.
 - The park boasts the spectacular Sanje Falls, one of Tanzania's tallest waterfalls at 170 meters, offering breathtaking views and a great hiking destination.
 - Udzungwa is part of the Eastern Arc Mountains, a global biodiversity hotspot, with over 400 bird species and a wide variety of rare plants and animals.
