- The Cango Caves are estimated to be around 20 million years old, with their impressive **stalactites** and **stalagmites** formed through the slow dripping of water over millennia.
- The caves extend over 4 kilometers in length, although only a small portion is open to tourists. The vast chambers and intricate tunnels make it a fascinating underground labyrinth to explore.
- Archaeological excavations have revealed evidence of human occupation dating back more than 10,000 years, making the Cango Caves one of the oldest inhabited caves in South Africa.
