- The island's waters are home to the rare and colorful Mauritius parrotfish, as well as occasional sightings of the elusive dugong, a marine herbivore.
- Thanks to the island's coral reefs and natural lagoons, Mauritius enjoys exceptionally clear waters, often with visibility exceeding 30 meters (98 feet), making underwater exploration particularly stunning.
