 - consider hiring a local guide for safer navigation
 - Be ready for higher altitudes, which can affect breathing and energy levels
 - Secure accommodations and guided tours ahead of time
 - Bring water, sunscreen, and a hat for sun protection

- The Chyulu Hills are a volcanic range formed by lava flows from ancient eruptions, resulting in fascinating geological features like lava tubes and caves.
 - The park's high altitude and lush vegetation provide a cooling effect on the surrounding region, making it a refreshing contrast to Kenya's more arid landscapes
 - On clear days, the park offers stunning views of Mount Kilimanjaro, which appears majestically across the border in Tanzania, providing a dramatic backdrop to the park's landscape.
