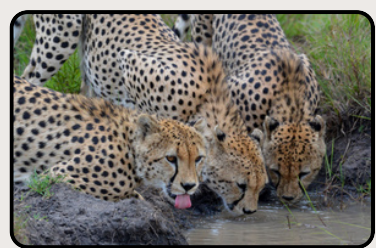

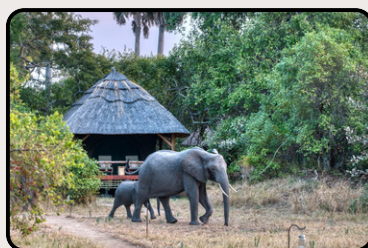

- The park is one of Tanzania's most isolated and least-visited national parks, offering an untouched, authentic safari experience far from the usual tourist routes.
- Katavi is known for its large herds of buffalo, often seen in impressive numbers. During the dry season, these herds gather around water sources, creating dramatic wildlife spectacles.
