- The garden is home to the Victoria Amazonica, one of the world's largest water lilies, with leaves that can reach up to 3 meters in diameter and support a significant amount of weight.
- Established in 1735 by French Governor Bertrand-François Mahé de La Bourdonnais, Pamplemousses Garden is one of the oldest botanical gardens in the Southern Hemisphere, showcasing its rich historical legacy.
