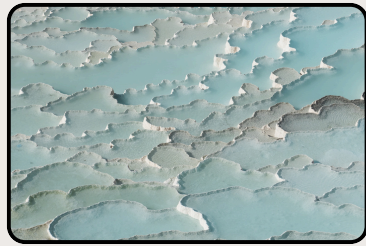

"PAMUKKALE'S CRYSTAL CASCADES: TURKEY'S NATURAL WONDER"

Pamukkale in southwestern Turkey is famed for its stunning thermal pools and travertine terraces, formed by mineral-rich thermal waters cascading down the mountainside. Known as the **"cotton castle,"** these white terraces offer visitors a chance to walk barefoot in warm, healing waters believed to have therapeutic properties. Adjacent to Pamukkale lies **Hierapolis**, an ancient Roman city with well-preserved ruins, including a theater and Cleopatra's Pool, where submerged Roman columns add to the site's allure. This UNESCO World Heritage Site attracts tourists with its natural beauty, historical significance, and unique geological formations.

DID YOU KNOW?

- The travertine terraces of Pamukkale are formed by calcium carbonate deposits left by flowing thermal waters over thousands of years, creating a unique "cotton castle" appearance.
- The thermal pools of Pamukkale have been used since ancient times for their reputed therapeutic properties, attracting visitors seeking relaxation and wellness.
- **Cleopatra's pool** in Hierapolis, adjacent to Pamukkale, is said to have been a favorite bathing spot of Cleopatra herself, with submerged ancient ruins adding to its allure as a historical and recreational site.
