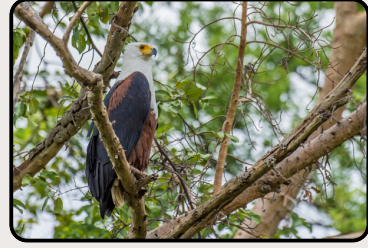

 - Consider packing a dust mask or scarf, as the reserve can be dusty

- Meru National Park was a key site for the renowned conservationist George Adamson, who, along with his wife Joy, successfully rehabilitated and reintroduced lions into the wild, famously chronicled in the book and film Born Free.
 - The park is one of the best places in Kenya to spot the elusive Pel's fishing owl, a rare bird known for its impressive hunting skills along the rivers.
